Why do we charge? The government provides an hourly funding rate to cover delivery of the EYFS. However, to provide all the additional activities for your children and delivering the high-quality education we provide there are additional voluntary charges. You will see on your invoice that your funded hours are ‘free’ and as our operational costs fluctuate throughout the year, it is not feasible to itemise the services for each individual expense. We have established these costs to contribute towards a fully inclusive and flexible package.		Morning or Afternoon sessions £1.50 per session

Parents will be asked to sign a contract for the Additional Voluntary Services and can cancel by giving a Full Terms notice. Parents that opt out will be provided with a list of items your child will require for each session, and activities your child will not take part in.		

Tax Free Childcare – Parents will find information on the Nursery Education Funding and the Governments Tax Free Childcare at www.childcarechoices.gov.uk. For every £8 parents pay into their online account, the government will add an extra £2, up to £2,000 per child per year. The money can then be used to cover your nursery invoices.

Funded hours, unused during term time, can be used in Holiday Club – see below

Holiday Club Charges – Parents book as required

Holiday Club is only available to children that are registered with Cornmeadow Early Years & Families. We operate 9am – 5pm at Easter for two weeks and the first five weeks of Summer Holiday.

Hot lunches are not available during Holiday Club– parents will need to provide a healthy packed lunch.

Parents can use funded hours for all Holiday Club hours booked with a Snacks Charge made for all funded sessions.

Late Collection Fee – Parents arriving 5 minutes late to collect children will be charged £25 and £25 for each additional 10 minutes or part thereof.
