CLOTHING, FOOTWEAR, HATS & SUNCREAM

We hope to experience some sunny weather! We have free-flow play to our outside area; therefore it is vital that the children are protected from the sun. Hats that protect the children's faces, heads and necks should also be brought to every session, <u>with your child's name clearly</u> <u>marked</u>. Footwear needs to be protective around the toes and heels, lightweight, flexible and comfortable so that your child can participate on all equipment and in all activities (NO CROCS/OR OPEN SANDELS).

Please can you administer an 8-hour protection sun cream on your child before coming to nursery. We unfortunately don't have the staffing & time to administer sun cream to 60 children. However, if your child has to have a certain type of sun cream due to sensitive skin we can support you with this by administering during their session, an Eylog medication form will need to be completed by you and sent through to us giving permission to administer, the sun cream needs to be handed over at the door with your child's name clearly labelled on the front. Please check your sun cream dates, especially if they have been in the cupboard for some time, due to the short life span sun creams have, usually 12 to 18 months, they become ineffective.

CONFIRMATION OF PRE-SCHOOL PLACE

Unless you have been spoken to about changing days, I can confirm what you requested on your form in February is what has been allocated. We are full for next academic year, so there is no room for changing, your invoices will reflect what you have booked.

PRE-SCHOOL TASTER SESSIONS

Karen & Nikki will start this preparation soon. Once key groups have been finalised the staff will make visits to the Meadow Room, after which the children will make visits to the Forest Room. Karen will notify you when this is happening, so you can chat with your children to prepare them.

PRE-SCHOOL PARENTS EVENING

This will take place on Monday 4th July 7pm, it is an evening that parents are invited to whose children are moving into pre-school in September 2022. It will give you an insight of our expectations, curriculum plans, daily routines and how you as parents can support your child on this journey.

COMMONWEALTH GAMES WEEK

This will take place week beginning 13th June. Children will participate in fun sporty activities during their session. Please can they wear pumps or trainers, leggings, joggers or shorts for the week.

TRANSITION TO PRE-SCHOOL REPORTS

Week beginning June 13th staff will be writing your child's final report from the Early Years Meadow Room. This will be sent to you via your eylog account to read.
